

Download Author's Purpose Worksheet

There are three main reasons why an author writes something: to entertain, inform, or persuade (or sometimes all three at once!). This collection of worksheets presents short passages, advertisements, excerpts, recipes, and other samples, and the students must determine the reason behind the writing.

Author's Purpose Worksheet 6 – This worksheet has eleven additional practice problems about author's purpose. Students read the descriptions of the texts and determine whether the authors is attempting to entertain, inform, or persuade readers.
