The current population of Costa Rica is 5,004,335 as of Sunday, August 11, 2019, based on the latest United Nations estimates. Costa Rica population is equivalent to 0.06% of the total world population. Costa Rica ranks number 123 in the list of countries (and dependencies) by population.

Major infrastructure construction projects were planned as of 2002, but with the exception of road repair, most had not progressed. Industry represented 37% of GDP in 2000. The Costa Rican Investment and Development Board (CINDE), is designed to attract high quality foreign investment oriented toward exports.

There are two major student unions, the Federation of University Students of Costa Rica (FEUCR) and The Nation Federation of University Students (FEUNA). Several scouting organizations are active for youth. Costa Rica has chapters of Amnesty International and the Red Cross.

Culture of a Peaceful Nation Costa Rica has always remained ahead of the curve when compared to other developing nations moving the country forwards with the time. They have lacked the war and devastation that has plagued other Central American countries and caused them to fall behind the development of the western world.

Costa Rica had focused on sustainable development through robust social and environmental policies, she said. It had clean energy and an economic model low on carbon consumption, with the goal of becoming one of the first carbon-neutral countries in the world.

Costa Rica (/ ˈk ɔ s t ʔ ʔ r i ʔ k ʔ / ; Spanish: [ˈkosta ˈrika]; literally "Rich Coast"), officially the Republic of Costa Rica (Spanish: República de Costa Rica), is a sovereign state in Central America, bordered by Nicaragua to the north, the Caribbean Sea to the northeast, Panama to the southeast, the Pacific Ocean to the southwest, and Ecuador to the south of Cocos Island.
