

# Download Kuniyoshi The Faithful Samurai

Kuniyoshi The Faithful Samurai is a pioneering publication which deals with the most famous Japanese print series of the forty-seven masterless samurai (ronin) by artist Utagawa Kuniyoshi (1797-1861): the Seichu gishi den (1847-48) and its sequel the Seichu gishin den (1848).

This is a wonderful book, written by a lover of Kuniyoshi's art. Mr. Weinberg's work is intelligent and the reproductions are excellent. The author explains the layout of a woodblock print and gives a clear, concise and beautifully written description of each of the 47 Ronin.

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The Faithful Samurai: Kuniyoshi Woodblock Prints is organized by the Michigan Oriental Art Society and toured by ExhibitsUSA. The purpose of ExhibitsUSA is to create access to an array of arts and humanities exhibitions, nurture the development and understanding of diverse art forms and cultures, and encourage the expanding depth and breadth of cultural life in local communities. ExhibitsUSA is a national division of Mid-America Arts Alliance, a private, nonprofit organization founded in 1972.

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This traveling exhibition illustrates one of the most famous stories of revenge in Japanese history, outlining the exploits of the courageous 47 Ronin samurai who avenged the death of their master in the early eighteenth century.

The Faithful Samurai: Kuniyoshi Woodblock Prints tells this tale through the stunning triptychs, warrior prints, and bust portraits of artist Utagawa Kuniyoshi (1797–1861). In 1701, a feudal lord, Asano Naganori, was dishonored by Lord Kira, the Shogun's Master of Ceremonies.
