A lease termination letter may also be used to attempt to cancel a lease if the Tenant or Landlord has violated their lease by submitting a notice to quit, although, in this case, either party will usually have a time period to “cure” the issue. If the lease does not allow the lease to be terminated early the Tenant can make a formal request to terminate but it will be up to the Landlord to decide if they want to release the Tenant.

A lease termination letter is often to cancellation a business contract between two parties: tenant and landlord. The business between the two parties might have run its course or irreconcilable differences, making it difficult for the two to continue contracting.

Lease and rent agreements do not go on forever. Usually, a rental agreement is charted out with a particular time frame in mind and once the tenure is over, the tenants have to vacate the premises – unless an addendum for time increase is added into the original agreement.

A property owner may decide to terminate a tenant’s lease for a variety of reasons. In some cases this termination equates to nonrenewal. Although a property owner is not obligated to state the reason within the letter, it is generally within his or her best interest to do so.

Life changes. Sometimes, this includes a move. If you're in a lease, use our Tenant's Notice to Terminate Tenancy to give official notice to your landlord that you're moving out.
