Antique bisque porcelain dolls were manufactured in the mid-1800's through the early 1930's. Their popularity came from the realistic resemblance the bisque porcelain bore to human skin.

Light test: performed on a bisque doll head. The value of a bisque doll is determined by the quality of the bisque head. The doll's value is cut in half if there is a crack in the bisque.
